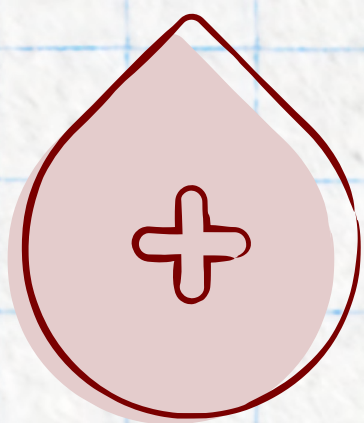
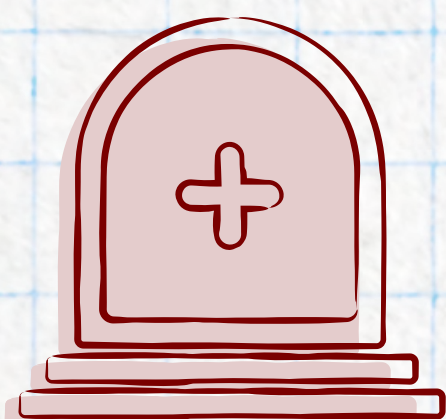


SEPSIS: SCREENING FOR EARLY ACTION
